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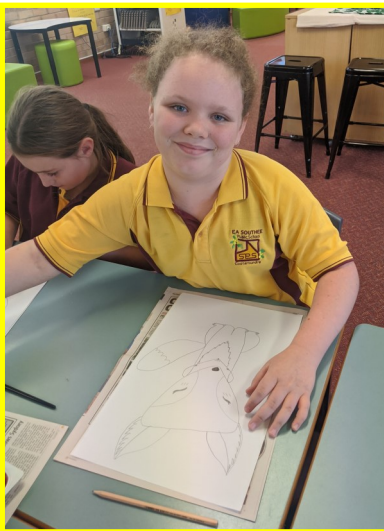

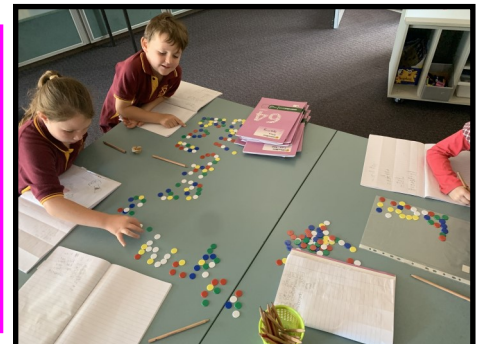
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Classroom Learning

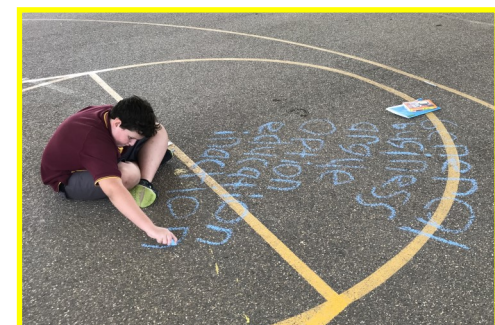
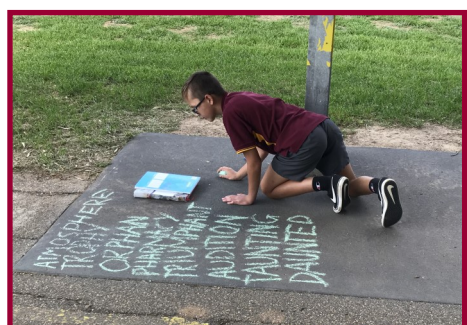
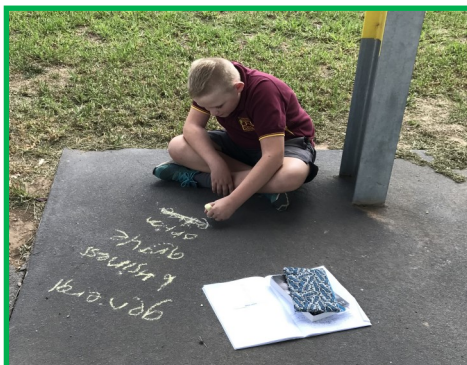
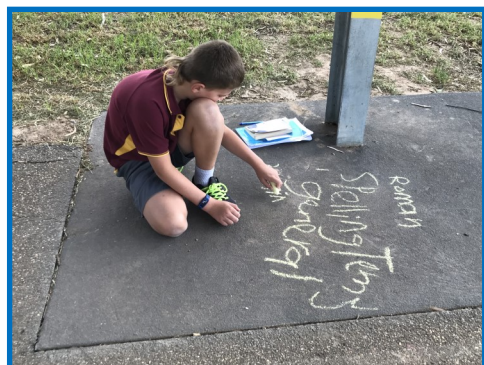


Team Giralang have been using counters to make their spelling words, focusing on the structure and formation of their letters. Practicing writing on the lines and understanding the difference between b and d.



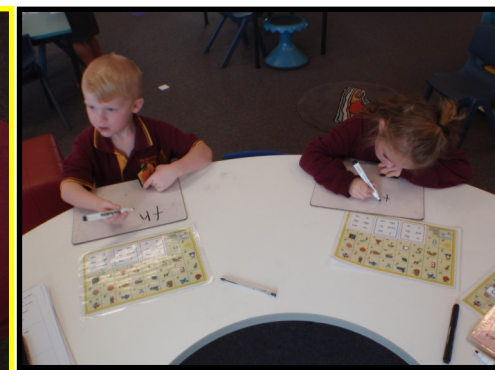

Due to no assembly being held for Week 9 we have presented Awards to students attending school this morning.

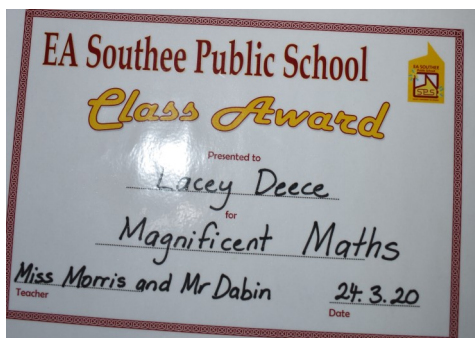
