
Student Learning

COURSE DESCRIPTION

The 'Our Story Time at Home' program will support families (including parents, grandparents or caregivers) by giving Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander children, aged 0 to 5 years, a good start in life through a range of literacy activities. 'Our Story Time at Home' is designed to increase participation and positive learning outcomes within family units.

These activities focus on sharing stories through reading, listening and communicating and it is hoped that during these art activities, the Aboriginal heritage of language and literacy practices will be more widely discussed and embraced.

HOW DOES IT WORK

Each week we will deliver a bag to your doorstep with everything you will need for a literacy activity, an art activity and a food item to share. The following week you leave your bag out with your completed art in it and our facilitator will exchange it for a new bag containing new activities for the next week. Each bag will contain different items that will follow our weekly theme and could include some reading activities, craft activities, games or cooking activities. In your package you will receive specific instructions to guide you through the activities with your children.

As a part of the program, we would like to collect the craft/art that you make each week to make a book or other product that you can keep. This product will be delivered to you shortly after the last week of the program.
