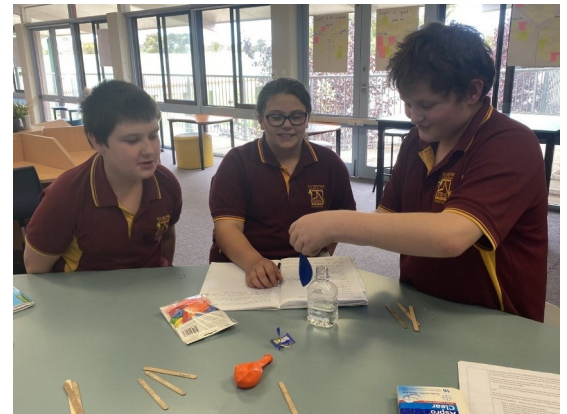
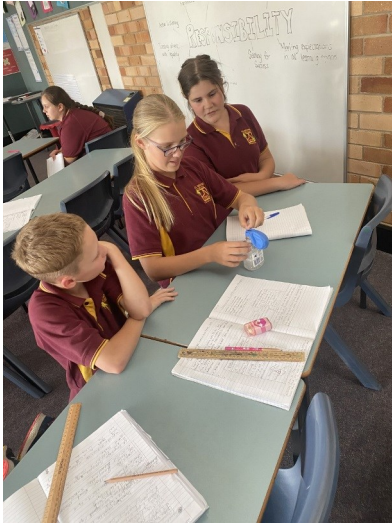

# Student Learning

Team 3 have continued their Science unit on Matter. They have been participating in a range of experiments to identify solids, liquids and gases and their properties. This experiment allowed students to discuss the reversible and irreversible changes in matter.

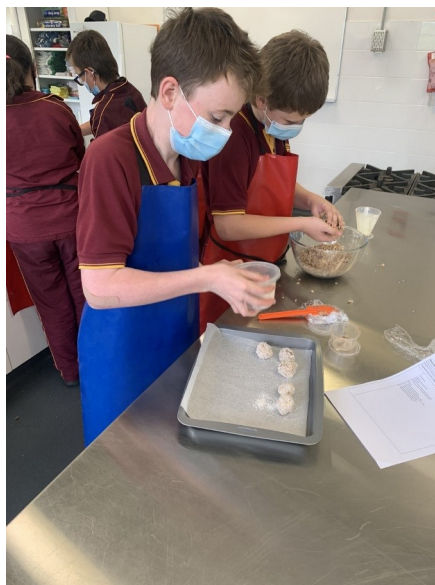
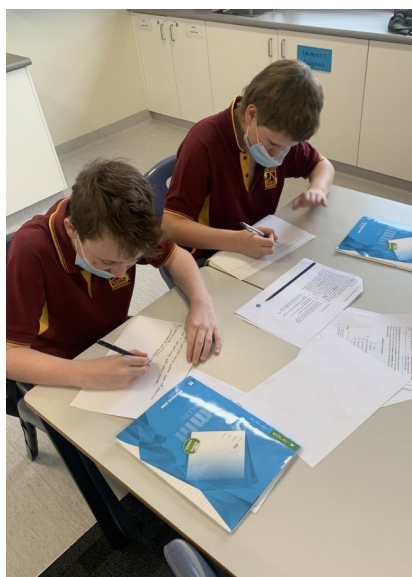

This week our Positive Behaviour for Learning (PBL) focus across the school is Respect.

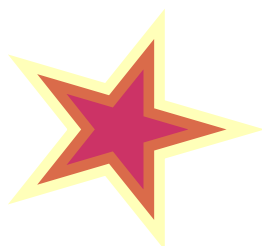
